

# Lake Coleridge Fishing Competition

The opening of the North Canterbury high country lakes is the first Saturday in November, which will be celebrated with a fishing competition at Lake Coleridge, with a great prize pool generously sponsored by Hunting and Fishing.

The focus of the competition is on participation - every angler who shows their licence at the weigh-in station at Ryton Bay will be in the draw for many spot prizes.

Weigh-in is from 9am – 1pm, with the prize draw around 1:30pm, please ensure you arrive at the weigh-in before 1pm to avoid missing out.

All fish must be caught in Lake Coleridge or the surrounding lakes, They must be whole and not gutted for the weigh-in.

There will be a free sausage sizzle all day.

Lake Coleridge is the most popular lake in the region for fishing and this event is a great way for anglers to celebrate the traditional high country opening.

Fish & Game has been stocking the lakes in the area for a number of years now, releasing thousands of rainbow trout and salmon into Lake Coleridge and its tributaries, with an additional 5,000 rainbows released into the surrounding lakes each year.
